Dog Companion - Walking, petting, brushing and playing with our dogs to improve their quality of life while in the shelter. This will also include changing dirty blankets, refilling water bowls, and occasionally cleaning a kennel when needed. *These shifts are available anytime we are open.*

Cat Companion - Petting, brushing and playing with our cats to improve their quality of life while in the shelter. This will also include changing dirty blankets, refilling water bowls, and occasionally cleaning a kennel when needed. *These shifts are available anytime we are open.*

Event Volunteer – Help with a variety of special events. This includes fundraising events, adoption events and/or educational events. Assisting with these events often includes set up and break down of event materials such as tables, chairs, games, booths, etc. *These shifts will vary, but **most** occur on weekends one to two times a month at various locations in the Quad Cities (such as pet supply stores, HSSC or city events, restaurants and breweries, etc.)*

Cleaning – Assist staff members with morning clean-up. *These shifts are 8am to 12pm any day of the week. We need assistance in both cat and dog kennels – you choose!*

Transportation – Requires a valid driver's license, your own car insurance policy, and a clean driving record. We have transportation needs to include picking up donations and taking pets to and from veterinary appointments. *These shifts will vary and we will contact you directly with dates and times as they are known.*
